New digital process for inpatient continued stay requests

Molina Healthcare is introducing a new digital option in the Availity Provider Portal. This allows providers to submit inpatient continued stay requests online.

What's changing

A new **Update** button will be added to the Availity Provider Portal to support digital submission of inpatient continued stay requests.

The Update button will be available:

- On the [Authorization Dashboard](#)
- Within the [Authorization Inquiry details page](#)

How it works

Providers can:

- Select an existing inpatient authorization
- Use the **Update** button to extend the service end date (forward only)
- Attach required clinical documentation (at least one attachment required)
- Submit the continued stay request online

The Submit button will remain disabled until an attachment is added. All standard file validation rules (file type, size, and security scanning) remain in place.

Why this matters

This enhancement:

- Reduces reliance on fax and manual submissions
- Supports a more efficient concurrent review process
- Provides a consistent digital experience aligned with other payers
