Informational Bulletin Regarding Emergency Declaration – Impacts of the March 2024 Storms

This is an advisory notification to Molina Healthcare of California (MHC) network providers applicable to all lines of business.

What you need to know:

On May 3, 2024, California Governor Gavin Newsom proclaimed a state of emergency to exist in Alameda, Contra Costa, Los Angeles, Marin, Mendocino, Monterey, Napa, Nevada, Plumas, San Bernardino, San Mateo, Santa Barbara, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, Trinity, and Ventura Counties due to the impacts of the March 2024 storms.

This notification is meant to provide a summary on those declarations and information that Molina Healthcare is sharing with our internal and external partners for communication.

Provider Action
