Do you want to get involved with a care organization to share your expertise and help develop programs before they roll out? Molina Healthcare of Illinois seeks physicians like you to participate in planning and oversight with only a modest time commitment from you.

Quality Improvement Committee (QIC)

QIC participants provide oversight and monitoring of the Illinois Quality Program, including policies and procedures, department performance, outcomes, etc. Medical doctors from any specialty are welcome, particularly from FQHCs.

- Meet quarterly for 90 minutes, 7:30 to 9 a.m. Central Time.
- Little to no prep work required.
- \$250 per hour stipend for participating.
- Provide feedback on a variety of issues to improve member outcomes, member and provider satisfaction, Molina operations, etc.
- Hosted by Molina senior leadership from Quality, Medical, Pharmacy, and other departments.

Professional Review Committee (PRC)

PRC participants review quality issues and advise on next steps (e.g., an action plan to prevent the quality issue in the future), as well as review outlier files that indicate issues with the provider's record. Medical doctors from any specialty are welcome, particularly OB-GYNs and surgeons.

- Meet bimonthly for 120 minutes, 8 to 10 a.m. Central Time.
- Roughly 30 minutes of prep work.
- \$250 per hour stipend for participating.
- Review credentialing for Wisconsin, quality issues for Illinois and Wisconsin, and review credentialing for Illinois Marketplace.
- Hosted by Molina's Dr. Raymond Zastrow and senior leadership from Quality, Medical, and Corporate Credentialing.

Volunteers for Either Committee

- Physicians who participate will receive a \$250 per hour stipend for attending.
- Perfect attendance is not required but it is strongly encouraged.
- You may participate in either one or both committees.
- Physicians of any specialty are welcome, and OB-GYNs, surgeons, and FQHC physicians are needed.
