MODEL OF CARE PROVIDER TRAINING 2026 Updates – Molina Healthcare Medicare Providers

What's New for 2026?

- **Existing Providers:** Only required to complete MOC training **once every 3 years!**
- **Compliance:** If outreach and attestation are documented, you're set for the cycle.
- **New Providers:** Must complete MOC training during orientation.

Why Complete MOC Training?

- ***Required by CMS for all contracted Medicare PCPs, Cardiology, Hematology/Oncology, and Psychiatry.***
- Ensure you understand how to support the Model of Care and manage members according to CMS standards.

How to Access Training

1. Go to <https://www.molinahealthcare.com/>
2. Select your State at the top of the homepage.
3. Click "Health Care Professionals" → "Medicare".
4. Scroll to the "Model of Care" section and click the training link.
5. Download and complete your State's Attestation Form.

FAQs

- **Already completed MOC training for another insurer?** - You must complete Molina's training separately.
- **How is training delivered?** - Online and via web conferencing. You can attend an online training session at <https://www.molinahealthcare.com/providers/wa/medicaid/comm/trainings.aspx>.
- **Attestation Forms:** Individual participants must submit their own forms. Groups can submit a single form, accompanied by an attendance log listing individual NPIs.
