# Health Homes Program Do you serve Medi-Cal Beneficiaries? with complex medical needs?

JUST THE FAX

This is an advisory notification to Molina Healthcare of California (MHC) network providers. Beginning January 1, 2019, Molina Healthcare of California implemented the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) **Health Homes Program** to serve eligible Medi-Cal beneficiaries with complex medical needs in San Bernardino and Riverside County. Beginning July 1, 2019, Molina Healthcare of California will implement the **Health Homes Program** in San Diego, Sacramento, Imperial and Los Angeles.

The purpose of the **Health Homes Program** is to drive the best quality outcomes for complex members through intensive care management that connect members to community and social agencies. Eligible Medi-Cal beneficiaries who choose to participate in the **Health Homes Program** will be provided with intensive care coordination by an entity known as a Community Based-Care Management Entity (CB-CME). The CB-CMEs may be community organizations, FQHCs, or IPAs and will be responsible to offer the services as identified below.

# Health Homes Core Services:

- Comprehensive Care Management
- Care Coordination
- Health Promotion
- Comprehensive Transitional Care
- Individual and Family Support Services
- Referral to Community & Social Supports
- Housing Navigation services (for the Homeless)

# If you serve Medi-Cal beneficiaries with complex medical needs then you may be contacted by a Community Based-Care Management Entity (CB-CME)

# Brief list of criteria

CB-CMEs are not responsible for providing Medi-Cal medical or behavioral health services. However, a CB-CME may contact you to support the care coordination for a beneficiary enrolled in the Health Homes program. CB-CMEs may ask you for medical information such as blood pressure information to support state-mandated reporting

If you are not contracted with Molina and wish to opt out of the Just the Fax, call (855) 322-4075, ext. 127413 Please leave provider name and fax number and you will be removed within 30 days. requirements. CB-CMEs may share information with you regarding the beneficiary's medication usage. CB-CMEs will also encourage members to visit their doctor and may arrange transportation or accompany members to the doctor at a member's request.
