What is a miscarriage?

A miscarriage is the loss of a baby before the 20th week of pregnancy. Many miscarriages occur because the baby is not growing normally.

What are the signs of a miscarriage?

- Bleeding from your vagina
- Pain or cramping in your abdomen or lower back
- Blood clots or grayish tissue coming from your vagina

What **risk factors** increase your chance of having a miscarriage?

- You are over 35 years old.
- You are over-weight or under-weight.
- You have had two or more miscarriages.
- You have a poorly controlled health problem, such as diabetes.
- You have a bacterial or viral infection.
- You recently were injured.
- You come into contact with harmful chemicals.
- You use drugs, alcohol or smoke while pregnant.

What does **NOT** cause a miscarriage?

- Exercise
- Having sex
- Working
