

Maternal Infant Health Program (MIHP) Revisions

In accordance with State of Michigan guidelines, Molina Healthcare of Michigan will incorporate the following provisions for the Maternal Infant Health Program:

- Only one assessment is allowed per pregnancy and per infant.
- Reimbursement is allowed for one professional visit per beneficiary per date of service, regardless of place of service.
- Maternal beneficiaries are only allowed up to **nine** professional visits per pregnancy.
- Infant beneficiaries are allowed up to **nine** professional visits. **Beginning August 1, 2020**, Molina will require notification with a physician's order beginning with the **10th** visit. Only 18 total visits are allowed.
- **Beginning August 1, 2020**, Molina will require notification with a physician's order that includes a diagnosis of drug-exposed infant for additional visits per state guidelines. With notification, up to 18 visits may be billed, using the drug-exposed procedure code(s).

For clarity, the following codes require notification effective August 1, 2020. Notification of the additional visits must be faxed to Molina at (800) 594-7404. Please consult the Molina website for notification information at www.molinahealthcare.com.

CPT	Notification Requirement
99402 – Infant professional visits	Required after 9 visits
96167/96168 – Infant drug-exposed visits	Required for all visits

Please ensure you are reviewing the MDHHS Provider Manual and MIHP Operations Guide for specific age requirements before rendering and billing for services.
