What is the overall deductible?	\$0 for <u>network providers</u> For <u>out- of-network</u> providers \$17,400 individual / \$34,800 family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. All covered medical services and preferred generic & brand drugs are covered before you meet your deductible for services received by network providers.
