599 CHIP Diagnosis Requirements

The 599 CHIP program is designed for unborn children of pregnant women who are otherwise ineligible for coverage under Medicaid or CHIP.

This program is not full Medicaid coverage and only applies to prenatal care and pregnancy-related services. These services are connected to the health of the unborn child, including labor and delivery.

To ensure compliant claims processing for the unborn child, Molina requires providers to include the pregnancy diagnosis in either the primary or secondary position of the claim.

Effective January 1, 2026, this requirement will be enforced and claims excluding the diagnosis or listing the diagnosis in a position other than the first or second, will be rejected. Claims processed prior to this date are subject to recovery.

Providers may want to consider submitting corrected claims if the pregnancy diagnosis was excluded or not billed in the primary or secondary position.
