Subject: Medical Record Review (MRR) - 2026

Dear Provider Partner,

Molina Healthcare will soon begin its Medical Record Review (MRR) process for Measurement Year (MY) 2025. This review involves requesting medical records from selected provider groups to address specific open care gaps. The goal is to ensure accurate reporting for HEDIS and other performance measures.

If your office is selected for MRR, records will include, but are not limited to, the following measures:

BPD: Blood Pressure Control for Patients with Diabetes

CBP: Controlling Blood Pressure

GSD: Glycemic Status Assessment for Patients with Diabetes

PPC: Timeliness of Prenatal Care and Postpartum Care

WCC: Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity for Children/Adolescents (BMI/Nutrition/Physical Activity)

Why is MRR important?

MRR helps close gaps that may not be fully captured through claims alone. This process supports capturing the full picture of care a member has received, improves coding practices, and ultimately enhances member outcomes while meeting regulatory and contractual requirements.

Timeline:

Initial outreach/request from Molina: February 2026

Deadline to return requested medical records: April 13, 2026
